Paradise Irrigation District invites community members to attend a Sept. 30 meeting (available online or in person) to learn about the various steps which the district might consider taking to pursue greater financial stability.

The meeting is one of many being held as part of the PID "Options Study" which will help the district ensure long-term sustainability and resiliency of the community's water system as Paradise moves toward recovery. Participation in the study was required of PID when the district received state funds to restore water service following the November 2018 Camp Fire. The fire caused the loss of about 90% of PID's customers—making continued water supply operations not financially sustainable until community recovery and rebuilding is more complete.

This week's meeting will provide an update on the current progress of the report and, most importantly, share a list of options the district might consider to ensure greater financial stability.
